COVID-19 // ALERT LEVEL

The 21st of September 2020 at 00h01 marks the start of level 1 in South Africa's National State of Disaster. Most normal activity can resume, with precautions and health guidelines followed at all times.

SOCIAL ACTIVITY

No limitation on personal movement but persons are encouraged to limit movement to essential travel.
Curfew 00h00 till 04h00

Mandatory use of cloth masks (including home-made ones to cover nose and mouth) and ensure hand hygiene when in public.

Restrictions apply to selected Social Activities. Awaiting full guidelines from Government. Should these restrictions apply, the HOA will distribute once published in the Government Gazette.

COMMON PROPERTY AMENITIES

Recreational common property amenities such as the swimming pool, braai areas and other recreational facilities within Silverstone may now be used and enjoyed by residents (in accordance with the Rules & Regulations of Silverstone) and subject to all persons wearing a face mask and strict adherence to all health and protocols and social distancing measures.

One should, however, keep in mind that this does not mean that the proverbial recreational flood gates are now open, as certain restrictions on gatherings remain in place. Such as no more than 50 people may use certain amenities at a time.

As we move to the promise of a blossoming and blooming Spring, the HOA would, once again, like to thank the Silverstone community for their co-operation during these challenging times and encourage its residents to continue to work together as a community to exercise caution and care.
